






JENNI ABDO / VOCAL COACH

Known for his ability to reveal not only the face but the soul of his subjects, Frank brings emotional depth and storytelling to each piece he creates..



Raised in East Los Angeles, Frank found refuge in art from a young age and went on to study under master artist Theodore Lukits. He later attended USC and the Art Center College of Design. Frank began his career at Lucasfilm's Industrial Light & Magic, creating matte paintings for iconic films like E.T., Return of the Jedi, Indiana Jones, and Star Trek II. He received an Emmy Award for his visual work on Ewok – The Battle for Endor.

Today, Frank paints from his studio in Auburn, CA, where he creates fine art portraits, teaches, and continues to engage culture through meaningful art. His work has been featured in national publications, Christian media, and even commissioned by the White House. Through every painting, Frank seeks to reflect the dignity, story, and spirit of each person he portrays.
